1. Wolves have thick coats that enable them to survive in the harshest conditions.
2. Their coat is thick in summer and thin in winter and has two layers. The inside layer is for insulation and the outer layer sheds water.
3. Wolves hunt in packs and are highly social animals.
4. Cooperative hunting helps them bring down larger animals such as bison and moose.
5. Because of their long legs and large paws, wolves are able to run many miles.
6. Their eye sight is about 20 times sharper than the human eye sight which enhances their ability to spot prey.
7. Wolves have a keen sense of smell. In fact, their sense of smell is 100 times stronger than ours!
8. Their sharp teeth make them the ultimate hunting predator.
9. Wolves howl to communicate . They also woof and bark to let others know when animals are approaching.
10. Their social behaviour has undoubtedly led to their survival over the years. All pack members help to raise pups and they take turns guarding the den.
